=> Below are important guidelines and standards that you are expected to maintain.

- ALL students are required and expected to read through the entire Canvas home page and be thoroughly knowledgeable of ALL the information that is contained on the Canvas home page.
- I expect all my students to access the Calculus 1 Video Instruction web site (<https://mystudentlink.net/instruction>) to prepare for each lecture before coming to each class.

I created this site to help improve and strengthen the weaknesses that students may have.

Each video encompasses what may be new learning for some or a refresher for others.

In the videos, I do a lot of conceptual teaching. I expect my students to develop a mastery of prerequisite concepts. Those who lack those concepts will have a very difficult time succeeding in Calculus 1.

- I expect ALL my students to be prepared to work as soon they walk in the door.

- Students are expected to access the Calculus 1 Video Instruction web site that I created. All the problems correspond to your Pearson Online HW. There is an archived video exam section on the site that covers past common exams.

You are expected to use that archived section to help you prepare for each common exam.

- A practice quiz is located in the assignment section on Canvas. All students are to use that practice quiz to learn how to upload their completed quizzes. Further details are located on the canvas home page.

=> General Information on Student Responsibilities

- Students who are experiencing circumstances that will not permit them to succeed in this class must communicate their situation to the DOS (Dean of Students) at the beginning of the semester.
